



# ShieldAll® 6023

## Twenty Five Year Limited Warranty Mold Growth

Protective Chemistries Incorporated (PCI) warrants to the applicator of ShieldAll® 6023 Fire Resistant Coating (the Product) that, for the twenty-five year limited warranty period from the application date, The Product will resist active visible mold growth on its surface under normal operating building conditions when applied to a clean, exposed interior surface in strict accordance with the application guide located on the Product's [Technical Data Sheet](#) and the additional requirements of this Warranty. A current copy of the product data sheet may be obtained from PCI via the website, [www.protectchem.com](http://www.protectchem.com). For any valid claim presented under this Warranty, PCI will provide a refund for the cost of the Product used for the individual dwelling or unit of the application.

**Qualification.** To qualify for this Warranty, all of the following requirements must be met:

- The substrate for application must be free of all dirt, debris, mold or other materials that will impede bonding of the Product to the substrate surface.
- The Product must be applied in accordance with the material application guide located on the product data sheet.
- The Product must be applied to an interior surface, unexposed to the exterior elements including rain and sunlight.

**Exclusions.** This Warranty does not cover, and PCI will have no liability for any damage or failure of the Product caused by, or due to, any of the following:

- Use of the Product that is applied one year after purchase date.
- Surface alterations, including painting, on the finished Product surface.
- Mold growth on accumulated material or debris on the Product surface.
- Removal, replacement and/or reparations to the surfaces treated with the Product made prior to notifying PCI of any claim.

**Warranty Claims. For a claim to be considered valid by PCI, the following conditions must be met:**

- The Applicator must notify PCI within 10 days of the discovery of the alleged defect in the Product covered by this Limited Warranty.
- When making a warranty claim, Applicator will supply via email ([info@protectchem.com](mailto:info@protectchem.com)) a copy of this Warranty, proof of product purchase, address of application, application surface type, square footage of application, gallons used for application, and photographs of the active mold growth on the surface of the Product.
- If requested, applicator will arrange to provide PCI with a reasonable opportunity to review and investigate the alleged defect.

This limited warranty is in place of all other warranties, express or implied. PCI expressly disclaims any other warranties, including warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. Although PCI may have suggested Product for an application, it is the sole responsibility of the applicator to determine the suitability of the Product for the intended use and purpose. The applicator assumes all risk and liability whatsoever regarding such suitability.

The remedy stated in this Warranty takes the place of all other remedies against PCI, and is the only remedy against PCI available to the Applicator or any other party related to the purchase and use of Product. In no event will PCI be liable for any special, indirect or consequential damages (including, but not limited to, lost profits, lost sales, injury to person or property or any other damages) arising out of the sale or use of Product or for any use or misuse of Product, regardless of the legal theory claimed, whether in tort or otherwise.
